



Live Stream 2020 - Frequently Asked Questions for Group Hosts

What is a livestream event?

All who are registered will join online at 6pm on 4/25 to watch inspiring testimonies of God's work among internationals from their living rooms or wherever they are.

Why are we doing a livestream event?

We care about the safety and health of you and your friends and believe that a live-stream is the best way to communicate how IFI is making a world of difference in the lives of internationals who are extending His love to their nations.

Will I still be needed as a Table (Group) Host?

Yes! We need your help now more than ever to tell your friends about IFI and personally invite them to this inspiring event. You will now be a **Group Host**! You will be inviting believing friends to pre-register using the e-vite system, be able to see who has responded and help IFI to follow up with those who have not responded.

What happens to the people who were already registered as guests before it was a livestream?

They don't need to do anything. IFI will be in communication with them about how to join the livestream.

Who should I invite?

Since it is an online event, now more people can participate! You are not limited to a table of 10 seats. Please be intentional about who you invite! Friends at church, in Central Ohio, and in other parts of the US who share your passion to see international students reached with the hope of the gospel so they can impact their countries. But please don't post this event on social media, such as Facebook.

How do I invite people?

Use the electronic reservation system to send a personal e-vite, ask them to pre-register by April 24th, and call them on the phone.

Should I do anything on the day of the event?

IFI will be sending postcards and emails, but please follow up with your friends to remind them to attend the livestream.
